Planning

The Council have commented on a number of recent development proposals of significance to the Village. The Parish Council have submitted comments on these proposals, but villagers are welcome to submit their own:

Former Mushroom Farm – Selby DC are currently considering a planning application for a retirement village on this site which stretches between Gateforth New Road and the by pass (just outside Gateforth Parish). The proposal involves 168 residential park caravans with associated communal facilities. The application can be viewed on Selby Public Access using the reference 2018/0743/FULM.

Viner Lane, Roe Lane, Birkin — a planning application (ref 2018/0681/FULM) has been submitted to use this barn as a biomass power facility. Whilst some way from the Parish it would attract a large number of heavy lorries along a number of single track lanes in the area, and through Gateforth village..

Ferrybridge Gas Power Station — a pre-application consultation from Scottish and Southern Energy (SSE) has been received. The main issue for Gateforth is the proposal to construct an "above ground installation" which includes 2 options for buildings and equipment off Pale Lane which would control a link between the existing high pressure gas pipeline which runs south of Gateforth, and their new pipeline. Plans provided by SSE have been posted on the village website, and there is also a dedicated website www.sse.com/ferrybridged.
