Dog Fouling

The Council continues to receive complaints about dog fouling which affects not only you and your children, but also visitors to the village. For example the Council has received a letter from a local Disability Group raising a number of issues including dog fouling. They have commented "Thankfully most of us wouldn't dream of leaving dog mess behind. Fouling of public areas by dog faeces has serious public health impacts. Not only that, it creates a terrible nuisance to all residents, but particularly those with disabilities. For those with sight loss, mobility issues, or using wheelchairs and mobility scooters, avoiding dog litter can be impossible and create horrible situations for people. Please think of others and clean up after your dog."

Phone Box

The village phone box needs some repair and painting before being put to use by village. Cllr Gordon McGlone has offered to head up the project but is looking for a couple of DIY volunteers to help him.
